



## **Bratislava or Bust – Rules of the Rally**

To ensure that your Adventure is well managed and you are kept safe throughout there are a few rules that have been set. There are also a few rules with regards to winning the rally and the monetary prizes on offer.

### **The Car**

You are welcome to bring any car you wish on the rally; depending on what the type of car is will depend on what prizes you are eligible for, but every car will be subject to the following rules:

1. The car must be fully road legal in the UK for the duration of the rally – This means that the car must have a current MOT, current road tax and current insurance for all of the drivers.
2. We reserve the right to refuse participation to any car that we deem unsafe either through normal wear and tear or through user modification.
3. At the end of the adventure, you will need to decide what you want to do with the car. The options are to drive back with the car, sell it, or scrap it. However whatever you decide to do, the vehicle is your responsibility until it is sold or scrapped, so leaving it at the local airport as you fly home, will not be acceptable.

### **The Drivers**

Each team must have at least two drivers who are insured to drive the car in all of the countries we will be visiting. Drivers are also responsible for adhering to all of the driving regulations in all of the countries that we are visiting.

### **Participant Behaviour**

Whilst we expect everyone to have fun, we need to ensure that we are courteous to other participants and the local communities that we meet during our adventure.

This means that it is not acceptable to tamper with or in any way damage someone else's car, even if they are all bangers. We will be visiting many fantastic places, with a diverse range of people, so we need to be mindful of local customs.

If we are approached by the authorities, we will comply fully with anything we are asked.

### **Navigation**

There is no prescribed route for the rally so it is entirely up to you to navigate and choose the route you wish to follow throughout the rally from the start to the end points. We would advise that you have suitable road maps and do some research prior to departure. In doing your research before you depart we are confident you will gain a better experience throughout the adventure.
