



Trishuli River Rafting and Chitwan Jungle Safari - Combined Extension



Trishuli River is the most easy-accessible one from Kathmandu. Rafting here can vary from a day to a week, depending upon the availability of time and interest. Scenic valleys and impressive gorges, exhilarating rapids and easier sections as well as the right amount of time all make it the perfect trip for first-time or experienced rafters.

In high water conditions, this will be the perfect river for a short blast with huge rapids and a turbo fast current. There are numerous exciting rapids as the name of Snail's nose, Teendevi, Malekhu rapid,

Monkey rapid, Upset, Surprise, Monsoon, Cotton Pony, Ladies Delight, S-Bend, Highway, Monsoon and Pinball Rapid. This makes your fun more challenging during high flows with a good mixture of continuous rapids and pleasant calm water

Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Kathmandu – Rafting Point, Full day rafting, Overnight on camp

Transfer to Charaundi (83 kms west) and start rafting till Kurintar. Provide cool lunch on the way. After arrival at Kurintar we will set up camp on the river and have dinner.

Day 02: Half day rafting, drive back to Kathmandu

After breakfast start rafting till lunch at Simaltal before transferring back to Kathmandu in the afternoon.

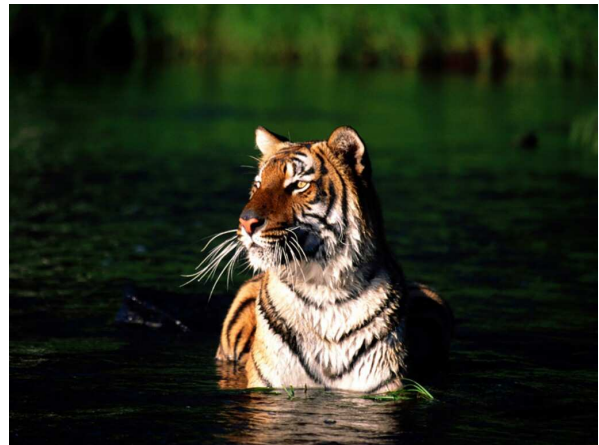
Please bring: -

Day 01 After breakfast at hotel, drive Chitwan National park for jungle safari

After breakfast at the hotel in Kathmandu we drive to Chitwan. (5 hrs, 220km) We will be welcomed with warm hospitality as we reach there. The park is home to the great one horned rhinoceros, sloth bear, wild boar, gaur (bison), 4 species of deer, 2 species of monkeys, 2 species of crocodiles, leopard, the elusive Royal Bengal Tiger, over 400 species of birds and various other reptiles. Briefing takes place as you arrive and lodges are assigned. Some activities takes place to penetrate deep into the jungle for viewing and photographing wildlife, experience the abundant bird-life, the flora and fauna. Overnight full board at Jungle Resort



Day 02 Jungle Excursion inside Chitwan National Park

Early morning you will be mounted on elephant back and then taken for a jungle safari for 2 -3 hours penetrating through dense 18-20 ft grasslands. It is the favourite habitat of the rhinoceros and other mammals. After breakfast you will be taken to the elephant stables where talk about the habits of the elephants takes place. Here you may witness the rare scene of the elephants at bath. Take your bathing suit along. In the afternoon you may just relax around the camp or take a dugout canoe ride down the Narayani River to view the gharial and the marsh mugger crocodiles. Dinner will be served around the campfire at the Resort.

Day 03 Morning activities at Jungle, Drive back to Kathmandu in the afternoon

This morning some activities like nature walk and bird watching take place before breakfast. After breakfast elephant, land rover and canoes will transfer you to waiting vehicles for the drive to Kathmandu. It is 200km and takes about 5 hours.
